



English Mock Exam Instructions

The English mock exam should be given between the middle of December and the end of January. We will use the 2019 essays for both Lang and Lit. All essays must arrive at my house by Saturday, **February 15th, 2019**. Any essays that do not reach me by that date will be returned unscored.

Multiple Choice

Since some of the Multiple -Choice questions have changed, we will decide in November which questions to use. I will send out an email explaining which questions to use.

Free Response (Essays)

Both AP Language and AP Literature

Use the 2019, Free Response Questions

1. Before printing cover sheets, **type in** the school/teacher code in the top right corner that says **School/teacher code. DO NOT allow students to write the number.** School codes will be sent out before December.
2. Print out the cover sheets and attach to the question.
3. Students will write their essays on lined paper and staple the cover sheet to their essays. Please do not use paper torn from notebooks. Cover sheets for both Lit and Lang should be printed out on the following color pages
 - a. Question 1 Pink
 - b. Question 2 green
 - c. Question 3 yellow

(only the cover sheet needs to be colored paper)

4. Students should write their name on the **BACK** of the cover sheet. Put initials on the essay pages.
5. **Staple the cover sheet to the essay.**
6. Separate the **synthesis essay (lang)** and the **open question (lit)** for teachers to score. Literature teachers will score their own Open question and Language teachers will score their own Synthesis question.
7. **Take out ALL essays that are blank, only a sentence or obviously a zero or 1. Keep those.**
8. Before sending essays to the State Director, **PLEASE put Language and Literature essays in SEPARATE envelopes or boxes. Do not mix them. Please make sure you list on the packet sent to me the name of the school from which they originate. Label everything so that I know which school has sent lang vs lit.. Please pay attention to which essay you keep for lang vs lit.**
9. Send the 2 essays (language AND Literature) to State Content Director, Tina Rose at

Please keep the language and Literature exams separate.

Remember!!!! All essays must reach this address by February 15th or they will NOT be scored.

School/Teacher Codes

Teachers in schools with multiple teachers in one subject will assign numbers to each teacher. For instance, If Henderson has 2 Language teachers then the student codes would be the school number, then the teacher number:

School # 32

Tina Rose teacher 1

Tina Rose's code would be 32/01

Amiee Webb teacher 2

Amiee Webb's code would be 32/02
